Submission

Manuscripts submitted for publication in the ICAIT should be brief; in good, idiomatic English, and must not exceed 7 pages, including title, authors and affiliations, abstract, key words, figures, tables, and references. All submissions must be in Microsoft Word.DOCX or LaTeX format and must use the **submission template**.

All submissions have to be sent online via [EasyChair](#) system. The submission guideline can be found [here](#).

Submissions open on May 17, 2024.

Submissions with fewer than 5 pages will be automatically rejected.

The ICAIT Committee has established **a maximum limit of 4 submissions per author** (including coauthored papers).

Journal Issue Fee

Fee is 150 Euro for each accepted paper without presentation on conference. Completed research papers must not exceed 7 more than 7 pages are allowed for an additional fee of 30 Euros per page.

Ethical Responsibilities of Authors

Papers to ICAIT must be original; submissions cannot have been published or accepted in other journals or conference proceedings. Further, submissions must not be currently under consideration for publication or presentation elsewhere. Results should be presented clearly, honestly, and without fabrication, falsification or inappropriate data manipulation. Authors should adhere to discipline-specific rules for acquiring, selecting and processing data.

Review

The journal operates a double-blind review process. All contributions are initially assessed by the Board of Chairs for suitability for the journal aims and scopes as well as for main topics. Papers deemed suitable are then typically sent to a minimum of two independent expert reviewers to assess the scientific quality of the paper. The journal adheres to the highest standards of publishing ethics, with strict rules in place to ensure this is achieved.

Author Presentations at ICAIT 2024

In the autumn issue the papers will be published in the Conference Proceeding Journal 2024 vol. 12(2) **without presentation at the conference.**

Copyright

By submitting the final paper to the editorial board, the authors agree to allow the editorial board to have non-exclusive use of the material for publication in the journal.

Indexing

The proceedings will be submitted for indexation by **Scopus**.

The proceedings of ICAIT 2016, 2017, 2018 (only Scopus), 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 (only Scopus) and 2023 issue 1 and issue 2 (only Scopus) have been successfully indexed in SCOPUS and Web of Science data bases.

Extended versions of selected papers will be published in **Springer series "Lecture Notes in Networks and Systems"**.
