Submission

Manuscripts submitted for publication in the ICAIIT should be brief; in good, idiomatic English, and must not exceed 7 pages, including title, authors and affiliations, abstract, key words, figures, tables, and references. All submissions must be in Microsoft Word.DOCX or LaTex format and must use the submission template. All submissions have to be sent online via **EasyChair** system. The submission guideline can be found here. Submissions open on October 12, 2024.

Submissions with fewer than 5 pages will be automatically rejected.

The ICAIIT Committee has established a maximum limit of 4 submissions per author (including coauthored papers).

Conference Fee

Fee is 100 Euro for each accepted paper without presentation on the conference. Completed research papers must not exceed 7 more than 7 pages are allowed for an additional fee of 50 Euros per page.

Ethical Responsibilities of Authors

Papers to ICAIIT must be original; submissions cannot have been published or accepted in other journals or conference proceedings. Further, submissions must not be currently under consideration for publication or presentation elsewhere. Results should be presented clearly, honestly, and without fabrication, falsification or inappropriate data manipulation. Authors should adhere to discipline-specific rules for acquiring, selecting and processing data.

Review

The journal operates a double-blind review process. All contributions are initially assessed by the Board of Chairs for suitability for the journal aims and scopes as well as for main topics. Papers deemed suitable are then typically sent to a minimum of two independent expert reviewers to assess the scientific quality of the paper. The journal adheres to the highest standards of publishing ethics, with strict rules in place to ensure this is achieved.

Author Presentations at ICAIIT 2025

In the spring issue, papers presented at the ICAIIT 2025 conference will be published in the Conference Proceedings Journal 2025, volume 13(1).

By submitting the final paper to the editorial board, the authors agree to allow the editorial board to have non-exclusive use of the material for publication in the journal.

Indexing

The proceedings will be submitted for indexation by **Scopus**.

The proceedings of ICAIT 2016, 2017, 2018 (only Scopus), 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 (only Scopus), 2023 (only Scopus) and 2024 issue 1 (only Scopus) have been successfully indexed in SCOPUS and Web of Science data bases.

Extended versions of selected papers will be published in Springer series "Lecture Notes in Networks and Systems".
