Submission

Manuscripts submitted for publication in the ICAIT should be brief; in good, idiomatic English, and must not exceed 7 pages, including title, authors and affiliations, abstract, key words, figures, tables, and references. All submissions must be in Microsoft Word.DOCX or LaTeX format and must use the **submission template**.

All submissions have to be sent online via **EasyChair** system. The submission guideline can be found [here](#).

Submissions with fewer than 5 pages will be automatically rejected.

The ICAIT Committee has established **a maximum limit of 4 submissions per author** (including coauthored papers).

Limit on the Number of Authors: A maximum of 8 authors per paper, with a maximum of 5 authors from the same organization.

Ethical Responsibilities of Authors

Papers to ICAIT must be original; submissions cannot have been published or accepted in other journals or conference proceedings. The minimum plagiarism threshold is 20%. Self-citation should not exceed 10%. Further, submissions must not be currently under consideration for publication or presentation elsewhere. Results should be presented clearly, honestly, and without fabrication, falsification or inappropriate data manipulation. Authors should adhere to discipline-specific rules for acquiring, selecting and processing data.

Review

The journal operates a double-blind review process. All contributions are initially assessed by the Board of Chairs for suitability for the journal aims and scopes as well as for main topics. Papers deemed suitable are then typically sent to a minimum of two independent expert reviewers to assess the scientific quality of the paper. The journal adheres to the highest standards of publishing ethics, with strict rules in place to ensure this is achieved.

Author Presentations at ICAIIT 2025

In the autumn issue the papers will be published in the Conference Proceeding Journal 2024 vol. 12(2) **without presentation at the conference.**

Copyright

By submitting the final paper to the editorial board, the authors agree to allow the editorial board to have non-exclusive use of the material for publication in the journal.

Indexing

Papers will be published under the imprint of Anhalt University of Applied Sciences ([Edition Hochschule Anhalt](#)), which will oversee the issuance of the **DOI**, **ISBN**, and **ISSN** identifiers.

The journal papers will be submitted for indexation by **SCOPUS**, **ROAJ**, **DOAJ**, and **Google Scholar**.

The proceedings of ICAIIT 2016, 2017, 2019, 2020, 2021 have been successfully indexed in Web of Science data base.

Additionally, the proceedings of **ICAIIT 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024** have been successfully indexed in **Scopus**.

Extended versions of selected papers will be published in **Springer series "[Lecture Notes in Networks and Systems](#)"**.
