Submission

Manuscripts submitted for publication in the ICAIT should be brief; in good, idiomatic English, and must not exceed 7 pages, including title, authors and affiliations, abstract, key words, figures, tables, and references. All submissions must be in Microsoft Word.DOCX and must use the **submission template**.

All submissions have to be sent online via [EasyChair](#) system. The submission guideline can be found [here](#).

Submissions with fewer than 5 pages will be automatically rejected.

The ICAIT Committee has established a **maximum limit of 4 submissions per author** (including coauthored papers).

Limit on the Number of Authors: A maximum of 10 authors per paper, with a maximum of 5 authors from the same organization.

Journal issue Fee

The conference Proceeding Journal issue Fee is **150 euros** for each accepted paper with presentation. Completed research papers **must not exceed seven (7) single-spaced pages** and must conform to the ICAIT submission template. Submissions more than 7 pages are allowed for an additional fee of 30 euros per page.

Ethical Responsibilities of Authors

Papers to ICAIT must be original; submissions cannot have been published or accepted in other journals or conference proceedings. Further, submissions must not be currently under consideration for publication or presentation elsewhere. Results should be presented clearly, honestly, and without fabrication, falsification or inappropriate data manipulation. Authors should adhere to discipline-specific rules for acquiring, selecting and processing data.

Review

The journal operates a double-blind review process. All contributions are initially assessed by the Board of Chairs for suitability for the journal aims and scopes as well as for main topics. Papers deemed suitable are then typically sent to a minimum of two independent expert reviewers to assess the scientific quality of the paper. The journal adheres to the highest standards of publishing ethics, with strict rules in place to ensure this is achieved.

Author Presentations at ICAIT 2026

In the spring issue, papers presented at the ICAIT 2026 conference will be published in the *Conference Proceedings Journal 2026, volume 14(3)*.

Copyright

By submitting the final paper to the editorial board, the authors agree to allow the editorial board to have non-exclusive use of the material for publication in the journal.

Indexing

Papers will be published under the imprint of Anhalt University of Applied Sciences ([Edition Hochschule Anhalt](#)), which will oversee the issuance of the DOI, ISBN, and ISSN identifiers.

The journal papers will be submitted for indexation by SCOPUS, ROAJ, DOAJ, and Google Scholar.

The proceedings of ICAIT 2016, 2017, 2019, 2020, 2021 have been successfully indexed in Web of Science data base.

Additionally, the proceedings of ICAIT 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024 and 2025 have been successfully indexed in Scopus.
